WENDELL CLAY MANSFIELD (1874-1939)

In 1910, W. C. Mansfield joined the staff of the U. S. National Museum, as a preparator for Dr. W. H. Dail. In time he completed a Doctor of Philosophy degree at George Washington University and rose through the ranks of the Geological Survey, ultimately statisning the grade of Geological Survey, ultimately Gulf and Atlantic Coastal Plain and resulted in almost 40 works on the faunas and stratig-raphy of the area.
